The 'Next of Kin Program' is a NSW Police initiative program for residents living alone at home where they can register with a preferred contact in case of an emergency.

What is the Next of Kin Program?

The next of Kin is the person **YOU** would like police to contact in case of an emergency.

The Next of Kin Program helps people living alone to have the contact details of their nominated person recorded at their local police station.

The contact details of your Next of Kin, as well as your doctor, dentist and any medical alerts that would help in an emergency will be entered onto a register. Any information provided will be securely stored and only accessed by NSW Police. This information may assist the police and emergency services to contact a relative or other nominated person if needed in an emergency.

How it works for you:

- If you choose to register, please complete the form where your preferred contact details will be entered onto our data base.
- When the registration form is received, your details will be entered onto a police data base and a unique registration number will be generated.
- Police will return a copy of your registration form to you, including a key ring and a sticker. The key ring will have your registration number on the key ring including the number on the sticker. We always recommend the key ring be kept with you and the sticker placed in an obvious location, such as the refrigerator or near the phone for easy access.
- The next of Kin Program is **FREE** to join.
