The driver licensing access program helps remove the barriers that prevent refugee and resettlement communities from entering the driver licensing system.

We can help you with:

- Understanding road rules and road safety
- Literacy, numeracy, and computer skills to prepare for the licence tests.
- Proof of identity
- Interacting with Service NSW and other government agencies
- Getting your logbook hours
- Access to roadworthy vehicles for driving practice.
- Subsidised driving lessons and supervised driving.
- Help to manage outstanding fines to allow you to get your licence.

We operate in the areas of Fairfield, Liverpool, Bankstown & Parramatta.

Volunteer Driver Mentors Needed

An opportunity to get involved and help refugees and resettlement communities in your area.

Provide supervised driving practice to participants to gain confidence behind the wheel.

All learners who have graduated from the Driving School have been assessed as being competent to progress to mentoring sessions.

Workshops to train and prepare mentors are provided.
